### **An Act To Improve Access to Automobile Insurance and Employment by Clarifying Driving Records**

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1256, sub-§5** is enacted to read:

3 **5. Driving record.** The Secretary of State shall change the driving record of a holder  
4 of a provisional license that is suspended under subsection 3 from indicating the suspension  
5 of the provisional license to indicating the motor vehicle violation committed that caused  
6 the suspension once the provisional license holder obtains a permanent unrestricted license  
7 under this chapter.

8 **Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §2471, sub-§3** is enacted to read:

9 **3. Driving record.** The Secretary of State shall change the driving record of a holder  
10 of a provisional license that is suspended under subsection 2 from indicating the suspension  
11 of the provisional license to indicating the motor vehicle violation committed that caused  
12 the suspension upon restoration of the license.

13 **Sec. 3. 29-A MRSA §2472, sub-§8** is enacted to read:

14 **8. Driving record.** The Secretary of State shall change the driving record of a holder  
15 of a provisional license that is suspended under subsection 2 from indicating the suspension  
16 of the provisional license to indicating the motor vehicle violation committed that caused  
17 the suspension upon restoration of the license under subsection 6.

18 **SUMMARY**

19 This bill requires the Secretary of State to change the driving record of a holder of a  
20 provisional license that is suspended for a motor vehicle violation from indicating the  
21 suspension of the license to indicating the motor vehicle violation committed that caused  
22 the suspension once the provisional license holder receives a permanent unrestricted license  
23 or the provisional license is restored.
