| 2 | Sec. 1. 15 MRSA §394 is enacted to read: |
| 3 | §394. Prohibited sale or transfer of firearms to certain persons |
| 4 5 | 1. Definitions. As used in this section, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings. |
| 6 | A. "Firearm" has the same meaning as in Title 17-A, section 2, subsection 12-A. |
| 7 8 | B. "Sell" has the same meaning as in Title 17-A, section 554-A, subsection 1, paragraph C. |
| 9 10 | C. "Transfer" has the same meaning as in Title 17-A, section 554-A, subsection 1, paragraph A. |
| 11 12 13 14 | 2. Sale or transfer prohibited. A person may not knowingly or intentionally sell or transfer a firearm to a person who is prohibited from owning, possessing or having under that person's control a firearm pursuant to section 393 and who does not have a permit issued under section 393. |
| 15 | Violation of this subsection is a Class D crime. |
| 16 | SUMMARY |
| 17 18 | This bill prohibits the sale or transfer of a firearm to a person who is prohibited from owning a firearm, possessing a firearm or having a firearm under that person's control. |
