1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §4208, first ¶**, as amended by PL 2007, c. 295, §1, is further
3 amended to read:

4 The Department of Public Safety is authorized to conduct defensive driving courses
5 for the purpose of promoting highway safety and to charge a registration fee of ~~\$35~~ \$65 to
6 participants in the defensive driving courses conducted under the auspices of the
7 department. The fee must be used to cover the cost of conducting the courses. Any balances
8 remaining at the end of the fiscal year may not lapse but must be carried forward to be used
9 for the purposes stated in this section.

10 **SUMMARY**

11 This bill increases from \$35 to \$65 the registration fee for defensive driving courses
12 conducted under the auspices of the Department of Public Safety.
