1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §1001, sub-§15, ¶F**, as amended by PL 2005, c. 307, §1, is
3 further amended to read:

4 F. Establish policies and procedures concerning the removal of disruptive or violent
5 students or students threatening death or bodily harm to others from a classroom or a
6 school bus, as well as student disciplinary and placement decisions, when to identify,
7 assess and intervene with students who may pose a threat of violence to themselves or
8 others within the school community, including policies and procedures regarding
9 student supports, disciplinary actions and placement decisions if and when appropriate,
10 up to and including removal from a classroom or a school bus;

11 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill amends the provision of law governing a school board's adoption of a student
13 code of conduct to require the establishment of policies and procedures for students who
14 may pose a threat of violence in order to reflect best practices regarding behavioral threat
15 assessment and response.
