Resolve, Directing State Agencies That Maintain Public Lands for Recreation To Make Certain Information Readily Accessible to the General Public

Sec. 1. Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry, Bureau of Parks and Lands and Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to make information available on activities allowed and applicable rules for each parcel of recreational land. Resolved: That the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry, Bureau of Parks and Lands and the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall make information available on activities allowed and applicable rules for each parcel of land under the bureau's jurisdiction as described under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 1803 and for each parcel of land under the jurisdiction of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. The bureau and the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall provide information on how to access activities allowed and applicable rules. The bureau and the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall make such information readily accessible to the general public, including, but not limited to, on the bureau's and the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife's publicly accessible websites.

15 SUMMARY

This resolve requires the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry, Bureau of Parks and Lands and the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to make information available on activities allowed and applicable rules for each parcel of land under the bureau's jurisdiction and for each parcel of land under the jurisdiction of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. The resolve requires the bureau and the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to make the information readily accessible to the general public.
