2 Sec. 1. Scholarship program. The Maine Maritime Academy shall create the 3 Workforce Development Scholarship Program to provide scholarships in an amount not to 4 exceed \$1,250 for each student for a minimum of 115 students at the academy to assist 5 those students in earning the initial credits necessary to work at the Maine State Ferry 6 Service.

7 Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.
