An Act to Require Postage Prepaid Envelopes Be Provided for the Return of Absentee Ballots

1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §752, first ¶, as amended by PL 1985, c. 357, §8, is further amended to read:
4 5 6 7 8	At least 3 months before any election, the Secretary of State shall furnish each municipality with a reasonable number of dated absentee ballot applications. A reasonable time, not less than 30 days unless an emergency exists, before any election, the Secretary of State shall furnish each municipality with a reasonable number of absentee ballots and postage prepaid return envelopes.
9	SUMMARY
10 11	This bill requires the Secretary of State, when providing municipalities with absentee ballots, to also provide postage prepaid return envelopes for those absentee ballots.
