The amendment specifies that the legislation does not apply to the activities of a priest, rabbi, member of the clergy or minister unless that person receives monetary compensation specifically for those activities. This amendment also removes from the legislative findings and intent section language regarding the United Nations Committee against Torture and Human Rights.
