28 29 SUMMARY

This amendment is the majority report of the committee.

The bill requires the collection of data regarding traffic violation stops and for each law enforcement agency to collect the information and submit it to the Attorney General. The information collected and submitted to the Attorney General may not include personally identifiable information about any person who was stopped. The Attorney General is directed to compile and analyze all the information submitted by law enforcement agencies and provide a report of the analysis and any recommendations. The Attorney General's report may not include any personally identifiable information.

This amendment strikes from the bill the provision that creates a public records exception for personally identifiable information of a law enforcement officer or any other person involved in any activity for which data is collected. Because the Attorney General will not have and therefore cannot report any personally identifiable information about those who have been stopped, there is no need for statutory language to protect that information from public disclosure. If there is information reported about law enforcement

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- 1 officers who have violated the law and the policies prohibiting profiling, although the 2 information is not included in the Attorney General's report, it is not completely sealed 3 from public disclosure.
- 4 This amendment corrects the terminology from "traffic violation" to "traffic 5 infraction."
- 6 The amendment adds an appropriations and allocations section.
