COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 441, L.D. 702, “An Act to Designate January 6th as A Day to Remember and to Preserve the Accounts of Witnesses to the Events of January 6, 2021”

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act to Designate January 6th as A Day to Remember'**

Amend the bill in section 1 in the first line (page 1, line 2 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "**§150-V**" and inserting the following: '**§150-W**'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §150-V in the first line (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "**§150-V**" and inserting the following: '**§150-W**'

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2.

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, removes the provision of the bill that directs the State Archivist to collect and preserve firsthand accounts from the State's congressional delegation and staff and others connected to the events of January 6, 2021, to create educational materials based on those accounts and to make those materials and accounts available to the public through an online archive and physical exhibits. The amendment also changes a statutory section number to avoid a conflict with recently enacted law.
