COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 442, L.D. 703, “An Act to Establish a Health Care Gap Year Program for Recent College Graduates”

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

LABOR, DEPARTMENT OF

Employment Services Activity 0852

Initiative: Provides one-time funds in fiscal year 2025-26 and fiscal year 2026-27 only for a health care gap year program that incentivizes recent college graduates to work in critical health care positions, particularly in underserved and rural communities.
