COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 763, L.D. 1203, “An Act to Clarify Deadlines in the Freedom of Access Act and Disclosure Provisions in the Intelligence and Investigative Record Information Act”

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Clarify Deadlines in the Freedom of Access Act'

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 2 and 3.

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, retains the provision of the bill specifying that the reasonable time within which an agency or official having custody or control of a public record must provide both a good faith, nonbinding estimate of the time that it will take the agency or official to comply with the request and an estimate of the total cost that the agency may charge for responding to the request may not be longer than 30 days following the receipt of the request. The amendment strikes the remaining provisions of the bill.
