Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not 14 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 15 Whereas, Initiated Bill 2023, chapter 3 took effect on January 5, 2024, requiring motor vehicle manufacturers to make mechanical data emanating directly from a motor 16 vehicle available to the motor vehicle owner and 3rd parties via a standardized platform; 17 18 and 19 Whereas, pending litigation in this State and in multiple jurisdictions regarding 20 similar laws has resulted in significant uncertainty for vehicle owners, manufacturers and 21 repair shops and, in some cases, the deactivation of the telematics systems to comply with 22 overlapping or conflicting regulations; and 23 Whereas, the automotive right to repair statute directly impacts the security of 24 consumer data in this State and creates ambiguity in the secure management and 25 transmission of information from a telematics system; and 26 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within 27 the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 28 29 therefore.' 30 Amend the bill by adding before the summary the following: 31 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation 32 takes effect when approved.' 33 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section 34 number to read consecutively.
