COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 818, L.D. 1243, “An Act Regarding the Licensing of Assisted Living Facilities”

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph B in the 6th line (page 1, line 19 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "had begun" and inserting the following: 'received municipal approval and permits and project financing approvals prior to March 1, 2023 and began'

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph B in the last line (page 1, line 21 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "no" the following: 'quality of care and services or resident rights'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment includes a requirement that an assisted living facility that is applying for another license at the same license level must have received all municipal approvals and permits and financing approvals prior to March 1, 2023 in order to be granted a license. It clarifies that any violations of quality of care and services or resident rights would disqualify the applicant from being issued a license.
