## **SUMMARY** 1 2 This amendment removes from the resolve the requirement to develop with stakeholder 3 input a per member, per month rate and a 3-tiered rate for medication management. It specifies that the 25% increase on medication management is on the rates in place on 4 January 1, 2019 to reflect that the reimbursement rates for some providers of medication 5 management were increased pursuant to Public Law 2019, chapter 616, but that increase 6 7 was less than 25%. It requires the Department of Health and Human Services to apply a 8 cost-of-living increase to adjust reimbursement rates every 5 years.
