COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 838, L.D. 1263, “An Act Regarding Penalties for Fentanyl Trafficking When That Trafficking Results in an Overdose Causing Serious Bodily Injury of a Person”

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act Regarding Penalties for Fentanyl Trafficking When That Trafficking Results in Serious Bodily Injury of a Person'

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph L in the 3rd line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "W drug" the following: ', other than fentanyl powder'

Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph L-1 in the first line (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "resulting from an overdose"

Amend the bill in section 2 in paragraph L-1 in the last line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "resulting from the overdose"

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, changes the title. It amends the bill to remove the requirement that the serious bodily injury is the result of an overdose.
