Amend the resolve by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following:

**'Sec. 1. Child assertive community treatment teams. Resolved:** That, by December 31, 2025, the Department of Health and Human Services shall issue a request for applications for grants to establish pilot programs to develop 2 child assertive community treatment teams to serve the Lewiston and Bangor geographic areas. The request for applications must require the awardees of the grants to use workforce incentives designed to attract, train and retain child assertive community treatment staff. The department shall engage in a competitive process to determine the awardees. A single entity may be awarded both grants. The term of the contracts may not exceed 2 years.'

Amend the resolve in section 2 in the last line (page 1, line 32 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "programs." the following: "The joint standing committee is authorized to report out legislation related to the report to the next regular or special session after the report is received."

Amend the resolve by striking out all of section 3 and inserting the following:

**'Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved:** That the following appropriations and allocations are made.
