COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 1106, L.D. 1719, “An Act to Establish Substance Use Disorder Treatment Centers”

Amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 23 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 17 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "treatment." the following: 'One center must be located in Kennebec County and one center must be located in Washington County.'

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 5 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 5. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.
