Single municipalities.</b> Notwithstanding subsection 1, in the case of a regional school unit under this section that is composed of a single municipality, beginning after the approval and validation of a regional school unit's 2024-2025 school year budget, the regional school unit is not required to hold a budget validation referendum. A regional school unit may reinstate the budget validation referendum process in accordance with this subsection.
24 25 26 27	A. The regional school unit may reinstate the budget validation referendum process by a majority vote on a referendum question placed on the ballot in a general election pursuant to local referendum procedures as provided in Title 30-A, chapter 121 or in a municipal charter.
28 29 30 31	B. If the referendum question in paragraph A is adopted by the voters in the municipality, the regional school unit shall follow the budget validation referendum procedures as provided in this section and in section 1487 beginning in the next budget year.

34 35	4. Failure to approve budget. If the voters do not validate the budget approved in the regional school unit budget meeting at the budget validation referendum vote, the

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regional school unit board shall hold another regional school unit budget meeting in 1 accordance with this section and section 1485 at least 10 days but no longer than 45 days 2 after the referendum to vote on a budget approved by the regional school unit board. The 3 budget approved at the regional school unit budget meeting must be submitted to the voters 4 for validation at referendum if required in accordance with this section. The process must 5 be repeated until a budget is approved at a regional school unit budget meeting and 6 validated at referendum in accordance with this section and section 1485. If a budget is not 7 approved and validated before July 1st of each year, section 1487 applies. 8

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Sec. 3. 20-A MRSA §1487, as amended by PL 2007, c. 668, §21, is further amended to read:

#### 11 §1487. Failure to pass budget

12 If a budget for the operation of a regional school unit is not approved prior to July 1st, the latest budget approved at a regional school unit budget meeting and submitted to the 13 voters for validation at a referendum in accordance with section sections 1485 and 1486 is 14 automatically considered the budget for operational expenses for the ensuing year until a 15 16 final budget is approved, except that, when the regional school unit board delays the regional school unit budget meeting, the operating budget must be approved within 30 days 17 of the date the commissioner notifies the regional school unit board of the amount allocated 18 to the regional school unit under section 15689-B, or the latest budget submitted by the 19 20 regional school unit board becomes the operating budget for the next school year until a 21 budget is approved at a regional school unit budget meeting and validated at a referendum in accordance with sections 1485 and 1486. If the budget of a regional school unit is not 22 23 approved and validated in accordance with sections 1485 and 1486 before July 1st and the 24 officers of any affected municipality determine that the property taxes must be committed 25 in a timely manner to the collector pursuant to Title 36, section 709, the municipal assessor or assessors may commit the property taxes on the basis of the latest budget approved at a 26 regional school unit budget meeting and submitted to the voters for validation at a 27 referendum in accordance with section sections 1485 and 1486. 28

29 Sec. 4. Notification. By January 1, 2024, the Commissioner of Education shall notify the superintendent of each regional school unit in the State of the requirements 30 provided in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, section 1486, subsection 1-A.' 31

### 34 SUMMARY 35 This amendment replaces the bill and changes the title. The amendment provides that, for the purposes of budget approval and validation, a regional school unit that is composed 36 of a single municipality is not required to hold a budget validation referendum after the 37 38 validation of the 2024-2025 school year budget. The amendment provides that a regional 39 school unit composed of a single municipality may reinstate the budget validation referendum process with a majority vote on a referendum question placed on the ballot in 40
