COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 1353, L.D. 2023, “Resolve, to Establish a Working Group to Identify Ways to Manage Moorings on Inland Waters”

Amend the resolve in section 1 by inserting after subsection 4 the following:

'5. One representative representing municipal interests from a municipality with moorings on inland waters that has a mooring ordinance;

6. One representative representing municipal interests from a municipality with moorings on inland waters that does not have a mooring ordinance;'

Amend the resolve in section 1 by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.

Amend the resolve by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the unanimous report of the committee, amends the resolve by adding 2 members to the working group being established by the resolve: one representative representing municipal interests from a municipality with moorings on inland waters that has a mooring ordinance and one representative representing municipal interests from a municipality with moorings on inland waters that does not have a mooring ordinance.
