Report. 1	SUMMARY
2	This amendment replaces the bill, which is a concept draft. The amendment extends
3	the repeal date of the law governing airboat noise for one year, until September 30, 2023.
4	The amendment requires the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife and the
5	Commissioner of Marine Resources to reconvene the stakeholder group on airboat
6	operation and noise levels convened pursuant to Public Law 2021, chapter 166. The
7	Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife is directed to provide a report to the
8	Legislature by January 3, 2024 on the findings of the department and the stakeholder group.
9	After receiving the report, the joint standing committee of the Legislature having
10	jurisdiction over inland fisheries and wildlife matters may report out a bill relating to
11	airboats to the Second Regular Session of the 131st Legislature.
