COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 1415, L.D. 2100, “An Act to Update the Laws Regarding Fuel Gas Detector Requirements”

Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:

**'Mandate preamble.** This measure requires one or more local units of government to expand or modify activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures. Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21, 2/3 of all of the members elected to each House have determined it necessary to enact this measure.'

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 8 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 39 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "a state, county or municipal law enforcement officer;"

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment adds a mandate preamble and removes a provision that would allow state, county and municipal law enforcement officers to enforce fuel gas detector requirements.
