COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 1442, L.D. 2153, “An Act to Transfer the Responsibilities of the Governor's Energy Office to the Department of Energy Resources”

Amend the bill in Part B in section 1 in subparagraph (2-A) in the first line (page 24, line 37 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "2033" and inserting the following: '2027'

Amend the bill in Part B by inserting after section 8 the following:

'Sec. B-9. 35-A MRSA §10313, sub-§7, as enacted by PL 2025, c. 476, Pt. A, §16, is amended by amending the first blocked paragraph to read:

The commission shall approve or reject a contract within 120 calendar days, unless a longer period is requested by the department. If the commission approves a contract, the commission shall issue an order directing a transmission and distribution utility to act with respect to the contract within 120 calendar days, unless a longer period is requested by the department. If the commission does not approve a contract, the commission may direct that the contract be amended and resubmitted to the commission for approval.'

Amend the bill in Part B in section 9 in subsection 9 in the last line (page 27, line 5 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "~~disclosed~~" the following: ', except the department may share proposals and contract negotiation materials with the commission as necessary for the commission to approve a contract pursuant to subsection 7 and the department may make public certain information regarding submitted proposals at the conclusion of a solicitation, including, but not limited to, the identity of the bidder awarded a contract and the bid price'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
