COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 1493, L.D. 2214, “An Act to Confirm and Finalize the Boundary Between the Town of Kittery and the Town of York”

Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:

**'Emergency preamble. Whereas,** acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

**Whereas,** the communities of Kittery and York have experienced a history of border disputes and disagreement over the municipal boundary line between the 2 towns; and

**Whereas,** the 2 towns have reached a mutually agreed-upon description of their common boundary in an amicable manner; and

**Whereas,** it is in the public interest to immediately acknowledge the amicable settlement of the boundary line dispute between the 2 towns as mutually agreed upon; and

**Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Amend the bill by adding before the summary the following:

**'Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment amends the bill by adding an emergency preamble and emergency clause.
