COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 1496, L.D. 2219, “An Act to Implement the Recommendations of the Right To Know Advisory Committee Concerning Certain Existing Public Records Exceptions”

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 in paragraph D in the last line (page 1, line 15 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Evidence" and inserting the following: '~~Evidene~~ Unified Criminal Procedure'

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 3.

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment corrects a provision of law that refers to the Maine Rules of Evidence so that it refers to the Maine Rules of Unified Criminal Procedure. The amendment also removes that section of the bill that provides that personal contact information of an applicant for an adult use cannabis establishment license and employees of that establishment is not confidential if it has been provided as public contact information.
