COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 58, L.D. 36, “An Act to Clarify Processes of the Board of Environmental Protection”

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 4 in the 4th line (page 1, line 38 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "possible" the following: ', but in no case later than 90 days'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment amends the bill to provide that, for the purposes of the uncontrolled hazardous substance site laws, the Board of Environmental Protection must hold a hearing on an order regarding an uncontrolled hazardous substance site as expeditiously as possible, but in no case later than 90 days after receipt of an application for a hearing.
