This amendment removes from the resolve the provisions relating to requesting a waiver from the asset test for the federal supplemental nutrition assistance program and providing additional funds to eliminate the waiting list for home-delivered meals to

homebound individuals. The amendment also clarifies that the demonstration waiver for
medically tailored foods applies to individuals who are 60 years of age or older,
homebound and at risk for readmission to a health care facility. It changes the date for
reporting on the 2-year pilot project to January 1, 2023 and clarifies that the pilot project
goes forward only if the waiver is approved by the Federal Government.
