Amend the bill in section 2 in the last line (page 1, line 15 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "ordinances" the following: 'or comprehensive plans as defined in Title 30-A, section 4301, subsection 3'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

**Historic Preservation Commission 0036**

Initiative: Provides funding for the administrative costs associated with expanding eligibility for grants for the preservation and restoration of historic properties to allow for properties that have been designated as historic properties by municipal historic preservation ordinances or comprehensive plans.

This amendment adds to the bill historic properties designated by comprehensive plans to the eligibility requirements for grants for the preservation and restoration of historic properties through the Maine Historic Preservation Commission. The amendment also requires the Maine Historic Preservation Commission to include historic properties that have been designated as historic properties by comprehensive plans in receiving funding through bond proceeds authorized by Public Law 2023, chapter 653.
