COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 671, L.D. 1666, “An Act to Modernize the State Supplement to Supplemental Security Income by Updating the State Supplement and Removing Marriage Disincentives”

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 in the 9th and 10th lines (page 1, lines 12 and 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following: “~~except as provided under section 3273, subsection 1, paragraph B,~~” and inserting the following: ‘, except as provided under section 3273, subsection 1, paragraph B,’

Amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 1 by striking out all of paragraph A-1 (page 1, lines 32 to 35 in L.D.).

Amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 1 in paragraph B in the 5th and 6th lines (page 1, lines 40 and 41 in L.D.) by striking out the following: “~~\$30 a month 3 times the state supplemental income benefit calculated pursuant to paragraphs A and A-1~~” and inserting the following: ‘\$30 a month’

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 4 and 5.

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 7 and inserting the following:

‘Sec. 7. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.
