It adds to the membership of the Rural Health Services Task Force established in the bill a member who represents rural employers, appointed by the President of the Senate. It changes the member who is a provider of behavioral health services in a rural part of the State to a member who is from a statewide organization that represents providers of behavioral health services. The amendment also adds an appropriations and allocations section.
