COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 812, L.D. 1999, “An Act to Exclude Agricultural Leases from the Definition of "Subdivision" Under the Planning and Land Use Regulation Laws”

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph K in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 6 and 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "other than housing for migrant or seasonal farm workers"

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, provides that housing construction for migrant or seasonal farm workers on land primarily used for farming or ranching is not excluded from the definition of "subdivision" under the planning and land use regulation laws.
