COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ ” to S.P. 862, L.D. 2144, “Resolve, to Establish the Working Group to Prioritize Wellness and Mental Health Resources for Heritage Industries”

Amend the resolve in section 2 in subsection 7 in the first line (page 1, line 38 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "forestry or"

Amend the resolve in section 3 in subsection 1 in the first line (page 2, line 10 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "health" the following: ', primary care'

Amend the resolve in section 3 by inserting after subsection 1 the following:

'2. Consider the specific challenges for individuals with serious brain disorders and traumatic brain injuries working in heritage industries;'

Amend the resolve in section 3 by inserting after subsection 2 the following:

'3. Identify issues facing migrant workers;'

Amend the resolve in section 3 by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.

Amend the resolve by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the membership of the Working Group to Prioritize Wellness and Mental Health Resources for Heritage Industries to include a member representing logging rather than a member representing either forestry or logging. It also changes the duties of the working group by specifically including reviewing primary care resources for individuals in heritage industries, identifying issues facing migrant workers and considering the specific challenges for individuals with serious brain disorders and traumatic brain injuries working in heritage industries.
