HOUSE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to H.P. 377,
L.D. 609, “An Act Making Certain Appropriations and Allocations and Changing Certain
Provisions of Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government”

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part TT the following:

'PART UU

Sec. UU-1. 36 MRSA c. 843 is enacted to read:

CHAPTER 843

INCOME TAX ELIMINATION

§5501. Elimination of income tax

For tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2027, a tax may not be collected under
this Part.

**Sec. UU-2. Department of Administrative and Financial Services review
and report; references to income tax.** The Department of Administrative and
Financial Services shall review the provisions of the Maine Revised Statutes that refer to
Maine income tax and submit a report, including suggested legislation, to the Second
Regular Session of the 132nd Legislature identifying any changes necessary to implement
this Part.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment eliminates the Maine income tax beginning January 1, 2027. It
requires the Department of Administrative and Financial Services to review provisions of
law that refer to income tax and submit a report, including suggested legislation, to the
