An Act To Amend the Laws Governing the Gambling Control Board

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §1018, sub-§1, ¶**E,** as amended by PL 2005, c. 663, §7, is further amended to read:

E. The initial application fee for an employee license under section 1015 is \$250. The annual renewal fee for a one-year employee license is \$25. The renewal fee for a 3-year employee license is \$50.

Sec. 2. 8 MRSA §1018, sub-§2, as amended by PL 2021, c. 22, §6, is further amended to read:

2. Term of license; renewal, renewal fees. Except as provided in section 1071, subsection 6 for licenses to conduct advance deposit wagering <u>or as otherwise provided in this subsection</u>, licenses issued by the board under this chapter are effective for one year, unless revoked or surrendered pursuant to subchapter 5. <u>Employee licenses issued by the board under this chapter may be renewed for a one-year term or a 3-year term.</u> Upon proper application and payment of the required fees and taxes and in accordance with rules adopted by the board, the board may renew a license for an additional year if municipal approval has been obtained as provided in section 1012 or 1012-A. The board shall transfer \$25,000 of the renewal fee required by subsection 1, paragraph C to the municipality in which the slot machines are operated.
