SENATE AMENDMENT “ ” to H.P. 388, L.D. 620, “An Act to Provide Support Services for Military Members Transitioning to Civilian Life in Maine”

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

**Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §2430, sub-§3**, as amended by PL 2021, c. 181, Pt. A, §2, is further amended to read:

**3. Uses of the fund.** The fund may be used for expenses of the department to administer this chapter ~~or~~ for research in accordance with subsection 5 and for organizations in the State conducting outreach and providing support services to active duty military members and their families who are transitioning to civilian life, as allocated by the Legislature.

**Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.

**ADMINISTRATIVE AND FINANCIAL SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF**  
**Medical Use of Cannabis Fund Z265**

Initiative: Provides ongoing allocations to organizations in the State conducting outreach and providing support services to active duty military members and their families who are transitioning to civilian life.
