HOUSE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to H.P. 1112,  
L.D. 1677, “An Act to Establish the Alzheimer's Disease and Related Dementias  
Prevention and Support Program”

Amend the amendment in the first instructional paragraph in the last 4 lines (page 1,  
lines 13 to 16 in amendment) by striking out the following: "The department shall  
implement the requirements of this section to the extent possible given available resources  
and shall develop its budget for the program to include state matching funds for federal  
funds, regardless of whether federal funding is received. The department may seek and  
receive private grant funds to support the program." and inserting the following: 'The  
department shall implement the requirements of this chapter within existing budgeted  
resources. The department shall develop its budget for the requirements of this chapter to  
include state matching funds for federal funds, regardless of whether federal funding is  
received. The department may seek and receive private grant funds to support the  
requirements of this chapter.'

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 4 and inserting the following:

**'Sec. 4. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and  
allocations are made.

**HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF  
Healthy Brain Initiative Council N538**

Initiative: Provides allocations to establish a fund and allow expenditures.

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or  
section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment applies the provisions of Committee Amendment "A" to the requirements of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 22, chapter 279, which is enacted in the bill, rather than just to one section of that chapter, and it requires the Department of Health and Human Services to implement the requirements of the entire chapter within existing budgeted resources. It replaces the appropriations and allocations section.
