6 This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" to provide ongoing funds to be distributed by the Department of Education to career and technical education centers and 7 8 career and technical education regions with fewer than 1,000 students in grades 9 to 12 in 9 the centers' or regions' geographic boundaries to support the costs of having at least one 10 full-time instructor for every 8 students enrolled in approved programs offered by the centers or regions. It requires those centers and regions to submit to the department no 11 12 later than September 30th of each year a calculation of the difference between the funding 13 needed to support the cost of the direct instruction component of having one full-time instructor for every 8 students enrolled in approved programs and the funding provided for 14 the cost of the direct instruction component calculated in accordance with the Maine 15 Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, chapter 606-B.
