SENATE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to H.P. 651, L.D. 1004, “An Act to Ensure the Proper Operation of the State”

Amend the amendment in Part G by striking out all of section 1.

Amend the amendment in Part G in section 2 in **Sec. 3.** in the first line (page 5, line 9 in amendment) by striking out the following: "January 1, ~~2026~~ 2027" and inserting the following: 'January 1, 2026 90 days after adjournment of the Second Regular Session of the 132nd Legislature'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes the provision in Committee Amendment "A" that changes certain statutory date provisions enacted by Public Law 2025, chapter 523. It also changes the effective date provision in Public Law 2025, chapter 523 to indicate that chapter 523 takes effect 90 days after adjournment of the Second Regular Session of the 132nd Legislature, instead of January 1, 2027 as in the committee amendment.
