SENATE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to S.P. 598, L.D. 1457, “Resolve, to Allow the Maine Turnpike Authority to Conduct a Pilot Program to Implement Automated Speed Control Systems in Highway Work Zones”

Amend the amendment in section 10 in subsection 1 in the last line (page 7, line 36 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "person" the following: '. The authority shall own and maintain custody of personally identifiable information and the equipment on which it is stored. A vendor may not disclose personally identifiable information without permission from the authority'

Amend the amendment in section 10 in subsection 4 in paragraph A in the last line (page 8, line 33 in amendment) by striking out the following: "12 and 14" and inserting the following: '13 and 15'

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 10 the following:

'Sec. 11. Joint Advisory Group on Privacy Protection. Resolved: That the Joint Advisory Group on Privacy Protections, referred to in this section as "the advisory group," is established to advise the director on data handling and privacy protections to be contained in a contract entered into with a vendor under this resolve.

1. The advisory group is made up of 6 members who must be residents of the State at the time of their appointment. Members appointed to the advisory group are not subject to legislative review or senate confirmation. All members of the advisory group must be appointed prior to September 30, 2026. The advisory group consists of the following members:

- A. Two members of the Senate, one of whom must be appointed as joint chair of the advisory group, appointed by the President of the Senate;
- B. Two members of the House of Representatives, one of whom must be appointed as joint chair of the advisory group, appointed by the Speaker of the House;
- C. One member who is a resident of a county through which the Maine Turnpike runs, appointed by the President of the Senate; and
- D. One representative from the American Civil Liberties Union of Maine or another civil liberties organization, appointed by the Speaker of the House.
