SENATE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to H.P. 145, L.D. 222, “An Act to Establish a Take-back and Disposal Program for Firefighting and Fire-suppressing Foam to Which Perfluoroalkyl and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances Have Been Added”

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 5-A in the 2nd line (page 1, line 4 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "Marshal," the following: 'when funds are available.'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 5-A in the last line (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "subchapter 2-A," the following: 'The department may receive funds, grants or contributions from public or private sources to design and implement the program.'

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2 and inserting the following:

'**Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Firefighting Foam Disposal Program N968**

Initiative: Provides baseline allocation to establish an account to accept funding for contracted services related to the take-back and disposal of firefighting and fire-suppressing foam containing perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances.
