An Act to Provide Incentives to Employers to Provide On-site Child Care

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
CONCEPT DRAFT
SUMMARY
This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
This bill would provide incentives, including grants, to large employers that have a base in this State to provide subsidized, on-site child care for employees. The bill would require large employers that receive tax credits or other state money to provide on-site child care for employees in order to continue receiving the tax credit or state money. The bill would allow smaller employers to participate in the on-site child care paid for by the incentives by means of a sharing agreement. The bill would also make the incentives available to a large employer that is unable to provide on-site child care that pays at least 50% of the cost of its employees' expenses for child care obtained from a child care center in the community.
