SENATE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to H.P. 222, L.D. 348, “An Act to Make Menstrual Products Available in Certain Schools”

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill in section 1 in §6502 in the first indented paragraph in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 1, lines 5 and 6 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "in all school bathrooms"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Menstrual Products Reimbursement N391**

Initiative: Provides ongoing funds to reimburse school administrative units that serve students in grades 6 to 12 for the cost of making menstrual products available to students at no cost.
