1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §7105-A is enacted to read:
3	§7105-A. Automated telephone call reduction services
4 5 6 7	Beginning January 1, 2022, a telephone utility that offers any service to subscribers in the State designed to reduce the number of calls received by a subscriber that are made using an automated telephone calling device or an artificial or prerecorded voice shall offer the service free of cost to all subscribers in the State.
8 9	For the purposes of this section, "automated telephone calling device" has the same meaning as in Title 10, section 1498, subsection 1, paragraph A.
