7	SUMMARY
8 9 10 11 12 13	Current law authorizes the Department of Health and Human Services to cooperate and coordinate with other agencies, facilities or persons providing related services to families and children as part of the department's child abuse prevention efforts. This bill requires the department to provide for communication and information exchange among all the entities that are part of the child protection system during every child protective investigation.
