- 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
  - Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §709 is enacted to read:

3 §709. Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 compliance

4 The Commissioner of Transportation shall ensure that any Department of 5 Transportation project for construction, maintenance or repair of a public way results in the 6 public way meeting all applicable requirements of the federal Americans with Disabilities 7 Act of 1990. Any facility located in a public way, including but not limited to a utility 8 facility, that must be relocated in order to ensure compliance with the federal Americans 9 with Disabilities Act of 1990 under this section must be relocated at the expense of the 10 facility owner.

11 Sec. 2. 23 MRSA §3055 is enacted to read:

## 12 §3055. Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 compliance

A municipality shall ensure that any municipal project for construction, maintenance or repair of a public way results in the public way meeting all applicable requirements of the federal Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990. Any facility located in a public way, including but not limited to a utility facility, that must be relocated in order to ensure compliance with the federal Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 under this section must be relocated at the expense of the facility owner.

**SUMMARY** 

This bill requires that any project for construction, maintenance or repair of a road maintain the compliance of, or bring into compliance, the public way with the federal Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 and that any facility located in a public way that must be relocated in order to ensure compliance be relocated at the expense of the facility owner.
