Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 2 MRSA §2, as amended by PL 2019, c. 475, §9, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

§2. Expense account

1. Use by Governor. The "Governor's Expense Account" must be credited with those amounts that are appropriated by the Legislature for that purpose. This appropriation must be available for expenditure by the Governor at the Governor's discretion. This account is not subject to audit, except as to total amount to be paid and as provided in subsection 2.

2. Report of certain expenditures. Annually, by March 1st, the Governor shall submit a report to the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices detailing any expenditure of \$250 or more made from the Governor's Expense Account.

SUMMARY

This bill requires an annual report by the Governor to the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices of any expenditure of \$250 or more from the Governor's Expense Account.
