University of Maine System study; course regarding manufactured wood products. Resolved:** That the University of Maine System shall study the development of a course for midcareer architects and engineers on incorporating manufactured wood products into their work. In conducting the study, the University of Maine System shall examine the market demand for manufactured wood products and other climate-friendly building materials and pertinent midcareer training that already exists for architects and engineers.

Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That, by December 6, 2023, the University of Maine System shall submit a report based on its study in section 1, including a description of the proposed course, for presentation to the Second Regular Session of the 131st Legislature.
