Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §10657, sub-§1, ¶B, as enacted by PL 2007, c. 334, §1, is amended to read:

B. Enter or remain in or cause a projectile to enter or remain in or allow the person's hunting dog to enter or remain in any place in defiance of a lawful order not to enter or an order to vacate that was personally communicated to that person by the owner of the place or another authorized person.

SUMMARY

This bill prohibits a person engaging in an activity governed by the inland fisheries and wildlife laws from allowing the person's hunting dog to enter or remain in any place in defiance of a lawful order not to enter or an order to vacate that was personally communicated to that person by the owner of the place or another authorized person.
