1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §4012, sub-§1**, as amended by PL 2011, c. 402, §2, is further
3 amended to read:

4 **1. Immediate report.** Reports regarding abuse or neglect must be made immediately
5 by telephone to the department unless otherwise specified in this subsection and must be
6 followed by a written report within 48 hours if requested by the department.

7 ~~Hospitals, medical personnel~~ Medical professionals, hospitals and hospital staff, school
8 personnel and law enforcement personnel may submit ~~emergency~~ reports ~~through~~
9 ~~password-protected e-mail submissions.~~ ~~A faxed report may also be accepted when~~
10 ~~preceded by a telephone call informing the department of the incoming fax transmission~~
11 electronically. The department shall provide a portal through which these electronic reports
12 may be submitted that is linked to the department's comprehensive child welfare
13 information system.

14 **SUMMARY**

15 This bill amends outdated language regarding electronic submission of reports of
16 suspected abuse or neglect to the Department of Health and Human Services by removing
17 the language regarding secure e-mail and fax transmissions. Instead, electronic reports are
18 submitted through a portal provided by the department linked to the department's
19 comprehensive child welfare information system. The bill also expands the types of
20 mandated reporters who may report electronically to include school personnel.
