Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. Task force. The Department of Labor, Department of Education, Department of Health and Human Services and Maine State Housing Authority shall establish a task force to develop a statewide plan to assist immigrants who need housing, job training, language skills and transportation. The task force may invite the participation of other stakeholders in the work of the task force.

Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.
